





# Overview

HEALWA, the Health Evidence Resource for Washington State, is pleased to continue providing evidence-based health information to eligible licensed health care providers across Washington State. The program is completing its sixth year of operation. As the only evidence-based, statewide health information portal in the country, this unique and forward-thinking program continues to attract attention and interest from around the country.

HEALWA resources are available at any time, from any computer with internet access, to registered users at healwa.org. HEALWA is now providing accredited Continuing Education modules for Registered Nurses and some other professionals, which continue to be incentives to encourage eligible licensed health care providers to activate their access.

# Highlights for 2013-2014

Six new professions joined HEALWA, and a new Assistant Director joined the staff, and HEALWA embarked on an evaluation study.

The six new professions that joined HEALWA in February 2014 include: **Dietitians, Licensed Practical Nurses, Nutritionists, Occupational Therapists, Occupational Therapy Assistants**, and **Speech-Language Pathologists**. The program licensed new resources targeted toward their practice, namely Rehabilitation Reference Center and CINAHL Complete with Fulltext.

HEALWA, in cooperation with a consultant, undertook a planning process to evaluate the program in 2015. Tania Bardyn, PI engaged Moss Adams to consult on the formal evaluation study. The purpose of the study is to understand the value of HEALWA, evidence-based information services and to determine whether HEALWA aids in clinical decision-making and impacts the care of patients.

The University of Washington launched a national recruitment for an Assistant Director for HEALWA, following Valerie Lawrence's departure in March 2014.

**Gail Kouame**, MLIS joined the staff as Assistant Director for HEALWA on August 18, 2014. Previously, Ms. Kouame was the Consumer Health Coordinator and Public Health Coordinator for the National Network of Libraries of Medicine, Pacific Northwest Region (NN/LM PNR) in Seattle, WA. She brings 15 years of experience as a medical librarian to HEALWA, including skills of teaching and training, reviewing and overseeing health outreach projects, and promoting National Library of Medicine resources to diverse audiences.

## **Participation**

As of December 16, 2014, more than 23,500 licensed healthcare providers in Washington are registered HEALWA users.
This represents almost 14% of total eligible users (see: Number of Eligible and

Registered licensees, page 4). There has been an overall increase in usage among almost every health professional group since last year. The group with the highest percentage of eligible users is Naturopathic Physicians.

# **HEALWA Site Usage**

#### Average page views per month: 18,085

From November 1, 2013 through October 31, 2014 HEALWA had a total of 217,030 page views. This represents a 23% increase in total webpage views from 2012-2013.

Aside from the main HEALWA page and informational pages, the page with the greatest number of visits is the main Databases page, followed by the Toolkits page. The e-books page is also highly viewed. The Registered Nurse/LPN Toolkit page is the most visited of the Toolkits. Toolkits pages viewed on a regular basis include: Physicians/Physician Assistants; Therapists, Counselors, Psychologists and Social Workers; Massage Therapists; and Naturopathic Physicians.
