Patricia Devine became the Community Outreach Coordinator, managing the HEALWA Program, effective September 16, 2018. For the past 20 years, Pat has worked in various roles for the National Network of Libraries of Medicine, Pacific Northwest Region. She has passion for working with health professionals, community health workers, and community college librarians on issues such as health disparities, addiction medicine, and health literacy. HEALWA added Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians to the list of professions we serve in 2019.

The Department of Health submitted its 2020 supplemental budget and agency request legislation to the Governor's Office and the Office of Financial Management. Maintaining HEALWA's ongoing electronic resource budget was included in the decision package proposal, following feedback received in DOH stakeholder conversations. The proposal and will be reviewed and considered for the Governor's budget and approved policy agenda.

Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians added to HEALWA

After much hard work by HEALWA staff, WSU veterinary librarians Vicki Croft and Suzanne Fricke, the Washington State Veterinary Medical Association, University of Washington School of Medicine Governmental Relations Director Ian Goodhew and others, SB500, sponsored by Senator Guy Palumbo was signed into law on April 26, 2019. This bill adds Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians to the list of professions eligible to use HEALWA. In order to collect the necessary fees and register the new group of users, additional legislation is planned for the 2020 session, after which HEALWA will be fully funded to add veterinary resources to our collection.



HEALWA staff travelled to Olympia to attend the signing ceremony for SB500, along with representatives of the Washington State Veterinary Medical Association.

WSU Activities

An outreach coordinator at WSU Spokane taught 10 webinars designed to introduce participants to HEALWA's resources. Fourteen in-person workshops and exhibits were delivered to schools, nursing homes, hospitals, and clinics in Asotin, Spokane, and Whitman counties. The online self-guided HEALWA tutorial was updated and has been viewed 1399 times since November 1, 2018. Outreach to all nursing, social work, speech language pathology, occupational therapy, occupational therapy assistant, and massage therapy schools in Eastern Washington yielded more awareness of HEALWA as students graduate and gain their licensees.

In collaboration with the National Network of Libraries of Medicine Pacific Northwest Region (NNLM PNR) and Washington State University (WSU) Spokane, HEALWA has been working to improve the knowledge base of health professionals in Eastern Washington. The effort has included working with health practitioners — especially nurses working in clinics, long-term care facilities, and schools in Eastern Washington.
