In January 2020, HEALWA, the University of Washington Health Sciences Library, and the Network of the National Library of Medicine, Pacific NW Region, hosted an event called JAMA Open Day to introduce the Puget Sound research community to open publishing and provide knowledge associated with publishing for the JAMA Network Open Journal. Featured as keynote speaker was Frederick P. Rivara, MD, MPH, Editor in Chief, JAMA Network Open, Seattle Children's Guild Association Endowed Chair in Pediatric Research, Vice Chair and Professor, Department of Pediatrics, University of Washington. Other presentation included Open Researcher and Contributor (ORC)ID, Declaration on Research Assessment (DORA), Clinical Trials.gov, and the new PubMed.

Faculty, librarians and researchers of the University of Washington's Health Sciences Schools and the Institute of Translational Health Sciences, including community healthcare providers.

To develop sustainable regional engagement strategies and increase understanding and awareness of open access among researchers and faculty.
